



Status of the Criteria and Toxic Air Pollutant Reporting Regulation

- Establishes new annual reporting requirements for emissions data.
- The regulation changes the reporting requirements to make the content of the reported data and the deadlines for reporting to CARB more consistent across the state.
- Became effective on January 1, 2020.
 - Approximately 1,500 facilities currently subject to the regulation
- Amendments to the current regulation are being workshopped by CARB.
 - Considering
 - Require reporting for additional smaller sources
 - Minimize resource impacts using phase-in of requirements and abbreviated reporting
 - Final staff documents and proposed regulation tentatively expected to be made available in late Spring (45-day comment period)
 - A tentative Board date anticipated mid-to-late 2020
