This item will be considered at a meeting of the Board, which will commence at 9:00 a.m., July 26, 2018, and may continue at 8:30 a.m., on July 27, 2018. Background

On October 7, 2015, Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr. signed SB 350 into law. SB 350 requires load-serving entities under the jurisdiction of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and qualifying publicly owned utilities (jointly, retail electricity providers) to develop Integrated Resource Plans (IRP) that meet GHG emission reductions planning targets established by CARB in coordination with CPUC and the California Energy Commission. The GHG planning targets are to be developed for the electric sector as a whole and for each retail electricity provider.
