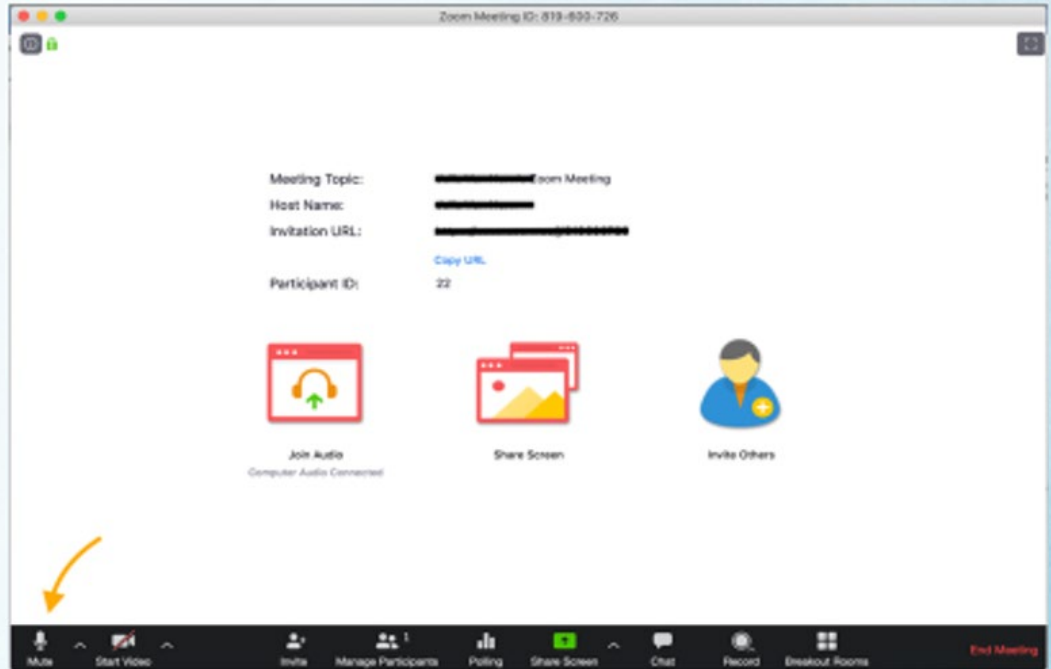

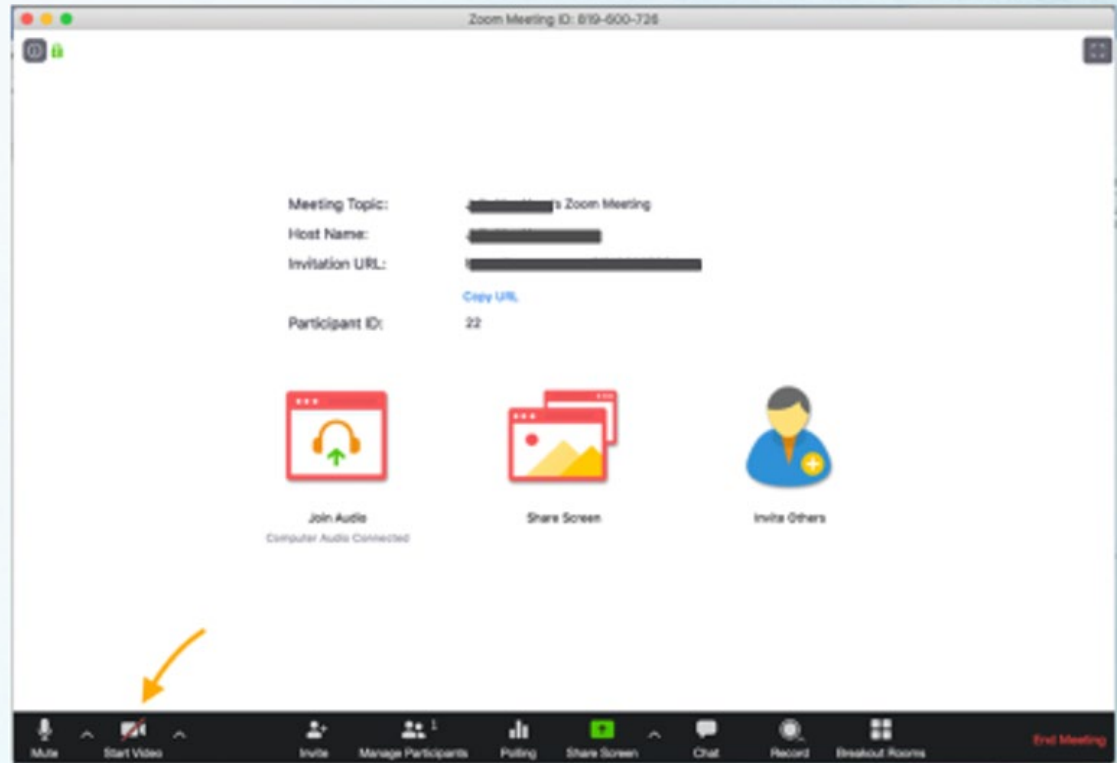

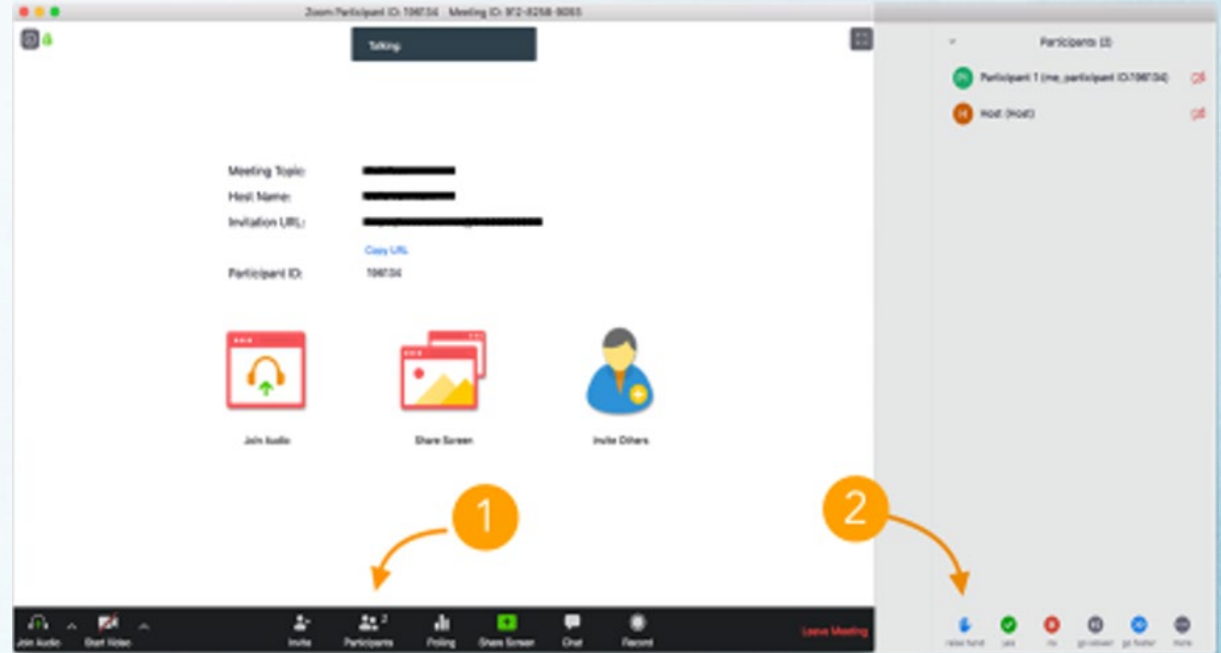
Click the camera icon at the bottom left of your screen to toggle your video on and off.



Raise Hand

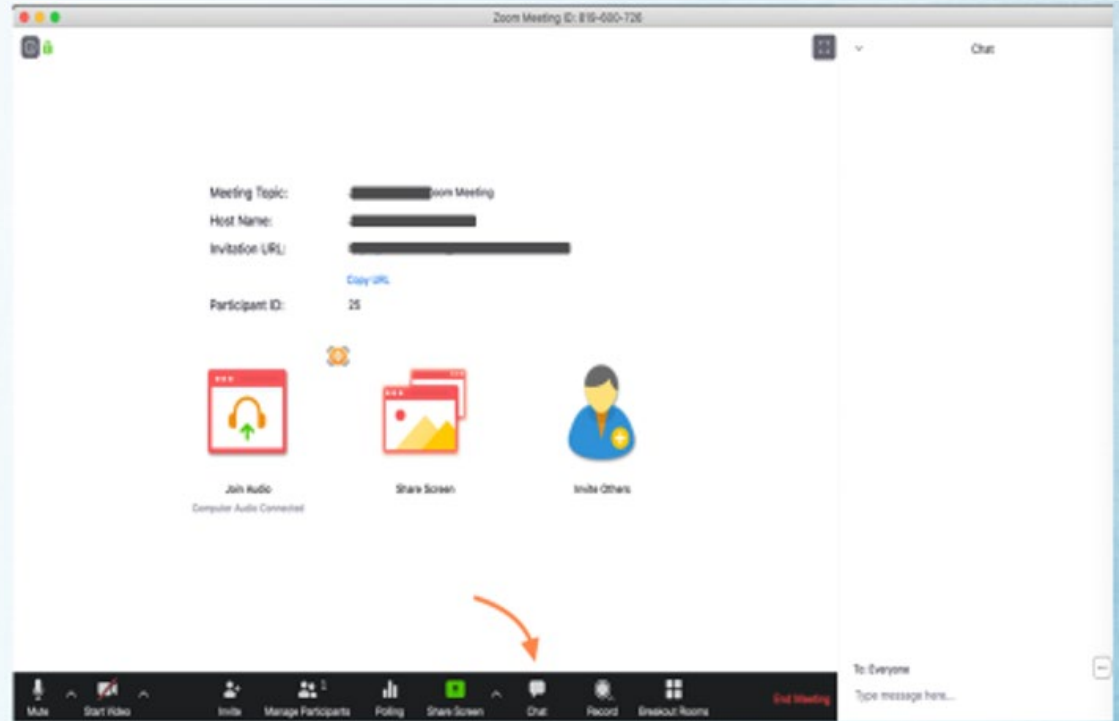

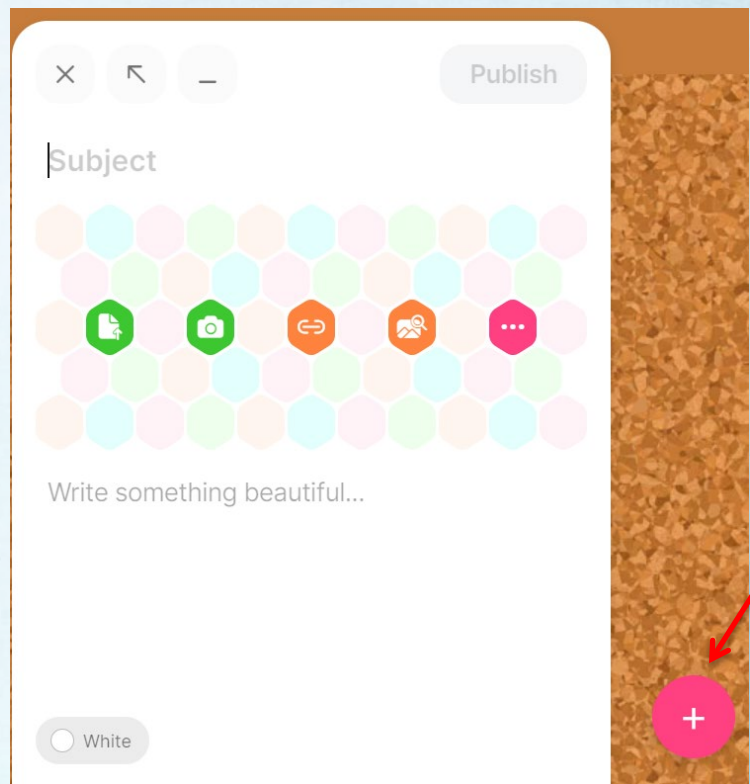
Chat

Framing the Conversation

- Not all changes are within CARB's authority
- CARB
 - Cumulative Impacts
 - Potential changes to HRA methodology (primarily OEHHA)
- OEHHA
 - Cumulative Impacts
 - Potential changes to HRA methodology

Framing the Conversation

- Air Districts
 - AB2588 trigger thresholds
 - Cumulative impacts with regards to permitting
- CAPCOA
 - Cumulative impacts with regards to permitting
 - Cumulative impacts trigger thresholds
- Land Use Agencies
 - Development and land use approval

Framing the Conversation

- Some changes may require formal review
 - Scientific Review Panel (SRP)
 - Public Comment
- Some changes may require legislation
 - Changes to authorities
- Limits to available staff resources

Future Discussions

- Different methods used for HRAs
- Development of cumulative impacts tools
