Subject: Commencement of Administrative Record for the Targeted Enforcement Administrative Modifications (TEAMs) Rulemaking

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) Enforcement Division (ED) received feedback from stakeholders that potential targeted, administrative modifications should be made to five regulations to improve the clarity and enforceability of the regulations. ED staff, in conjunction with CARB Transportation and Toxics Division and Industrial Strategies Division, developed potential modifications to accomplish these goals.

The potential TEAMs Rulemaking consists of targeted, administrative modifications to the following regulations: (1) Airborne Toxic Control Measure to Reduce Formaldehyde Emissions from Composite Wood Products; (2) California Diesel Fuel Regulations; (3) California Reformulated Gasoline Regulations; (4) Regulation for Mobile Cargo Handling Equipment at Ports and Intermodal Railyards; and the (5) Statewide Portable Equipment Registration Regulation.

CARB has preliminarily determined that the TEAMs Rulemaking will likely not be a “project” subject to CEQA because the amendments should not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts. However, CARB has determined that the administrative record for the TEAMs Rulemaking commenced on November 26, 2024. This was the date when CARB staff released the workshop materials related to the first concept development public workshop being held on December 10, 2024. CARB has prepared this memorandum to formally document the administrative record commencement date described above. This memorandum also serves to inform stakeholders that written materials submitted to CARB concerning the TEAMs rulemaking may be included in the administrative record for this item.
