DMS update

New Certification Documents Management System (DMS) Update

- CARB ECCD staff will be requesting new-users lists in the end of April or the beginning of May 2022 through a mailout/notice
- Planned activities during the old DMS to new DMS transition period
 - **Start** receiving new accounts (2 per manufacturer/vault)
 - **Start** receiving training
 - **Start** submitting into **CARB-eFILE (new system)**
 - **Stop** submitting into **CARB-DMS (old system)**
- Transition to the new system no sooner than the end of 2nd quarter 2022
- Stay tuned for more announcements regarding start up of CARB-eFILE!

Q&A for new DMS System

Q1. What is the anticipated implementation date for this new system?

A1. No sooner than the end of 2nd quarter 2022

Q2. Will there be a trial period where manufacturers can still use DMS if there are issues with e-FILE?

A2. No. There is no trial period. After e-FILE is operable, DMS will be decommissioned. CARB will inform all manufacturers ahead of time when to start using e-FILE and stop using DMS.

Q3. If manufacturers submit carryover/certification applications using the DMS system now, will applications need to be resubmitted in e-FILE, or will the DMS applications submitted until the e-FILE implementation date continue to be processed in DMS?

A3. Manufacturers just need submit certification document once. Applications submitted in DMS will be processed in DMS.

Status Update of the CIHD E-Cert Project

Recent and Current Development Activity

2021

- September: Workshop to Discuss Updates to Data Requirements
- October - December: Business Rules and Executive Order templates development

2022

- January - March: Priority projects suspended efforts on E-Cert
- April - May: Finalization of Business Rules and Executive Order templates
- June – December: Finalization of internal database and web form

2023

- January: Manufacturer testing begins
- April: Full implementation

Status Update of the CIHD E-Cert Project

Common Questions

Q: Where are the Data Requirements, XML Schema, and Business Rules documents?

A: These will be released together when all are finalized. This is scheduled for June 1st, 2022. This will provide around 9 months lead time before full implementation.

Q: What further guidance will manufacturers receive?

A: There will be a workshop that will discuss creating and submitting applications. This is expected to occur shortly before manufacturer testing begins. Staff will be trained to provide one-on-one guidance. The CIHD E-Cert webpage will be updated to include documentation and tutorials.

Q: How will manufacturers submit applications?

A: Manufacturers will submit XML files containing complete applications via the internet at the CARB E-Cert login webpage. Manufacturers will need to construct the XML files using their systems or the web form provided by CARB. A template form for Microsoft Infopath will not be provided.

Q: Will all applications in the first model year need to be submitted via E-Cert?

A: Not necessarily. Applications received after the full implementation date must be submitted via E-Cert. The system provides a field in which manufacturers can indicate for running changes / field fixes and carryover applications that the source application was submitted to CARB before E-Cert was fully implemented.
